The Blank Canvas Problem

New Notion users face a significant challenge: starting from an empty workspace with no clear direction. This leads to friction and abandonment before value is realized.



Empty Workspace

Users are greeted with a daunting, blank page, lacking any pre-defined structure or content.



Lack of Guidance

There's no immediate instruction on how to begin building or what the first meaningful action should be.



High Cognitive Load

Users experience mental strain trying to conceptualize and create structure from scratch.

This initial friction often results in users abandoning the platform before they can experience its full potential.

Why This Is a P0 Problem: Business Impact

Early user activation is critical for Notion. Without it, the powerful features remain untapped, directly impacting key business metrics.

Low First-Session Activation

New users struggle to complete a meaningful action in their initial session, hindering engagement.

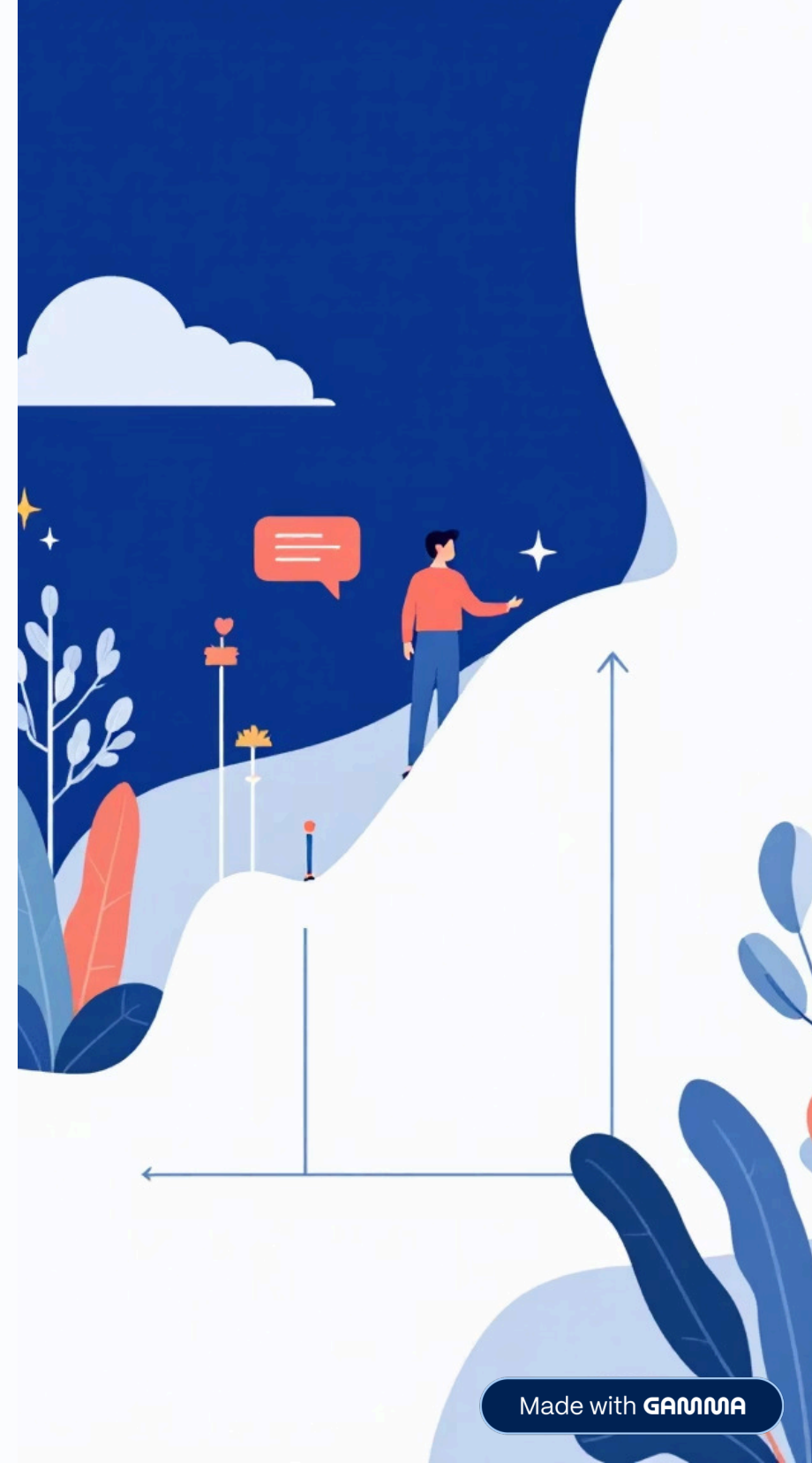
Drop-off Before Value

Users churn before experiencing the core benefits and utility of Notion.

Perception of Complexity

The initial blank state makes Notion seem more difficult than competitors, deterring adoption.

If users don't take a first meaningful action, the potential for long-term retention and expansion is severely limited.





Root Cause: Flexibility Without Context

Notion's strength lies in its flexibility, but this very strength becomes a weakness for new users lacking a starting point.

Notion's Intentional Flexibility

The platform is designed to be a versatile tool, adaptable to any use case, offering immense freedom.

However, this freedom without guided context can lead to decision paralysis, overwhelming new users.



The real gap: No system converts user intent into an immediate, usable workspace.

The AI Opportunity: Translating Intent into Structure

AI can bridge the gap between user intent and a ready-to-use workspace, transforming the onboarding experience.



Immediate Workspace

AI generates a tailored workspace instantly after a user specifies their goal.



Pre-organized Content

Workspaces come with pre-populated pages and databases, reducing setup time.



Reduced Decision-Making

Minimizes early choices, allowing users to dive straight into productivity.



Clear First Step

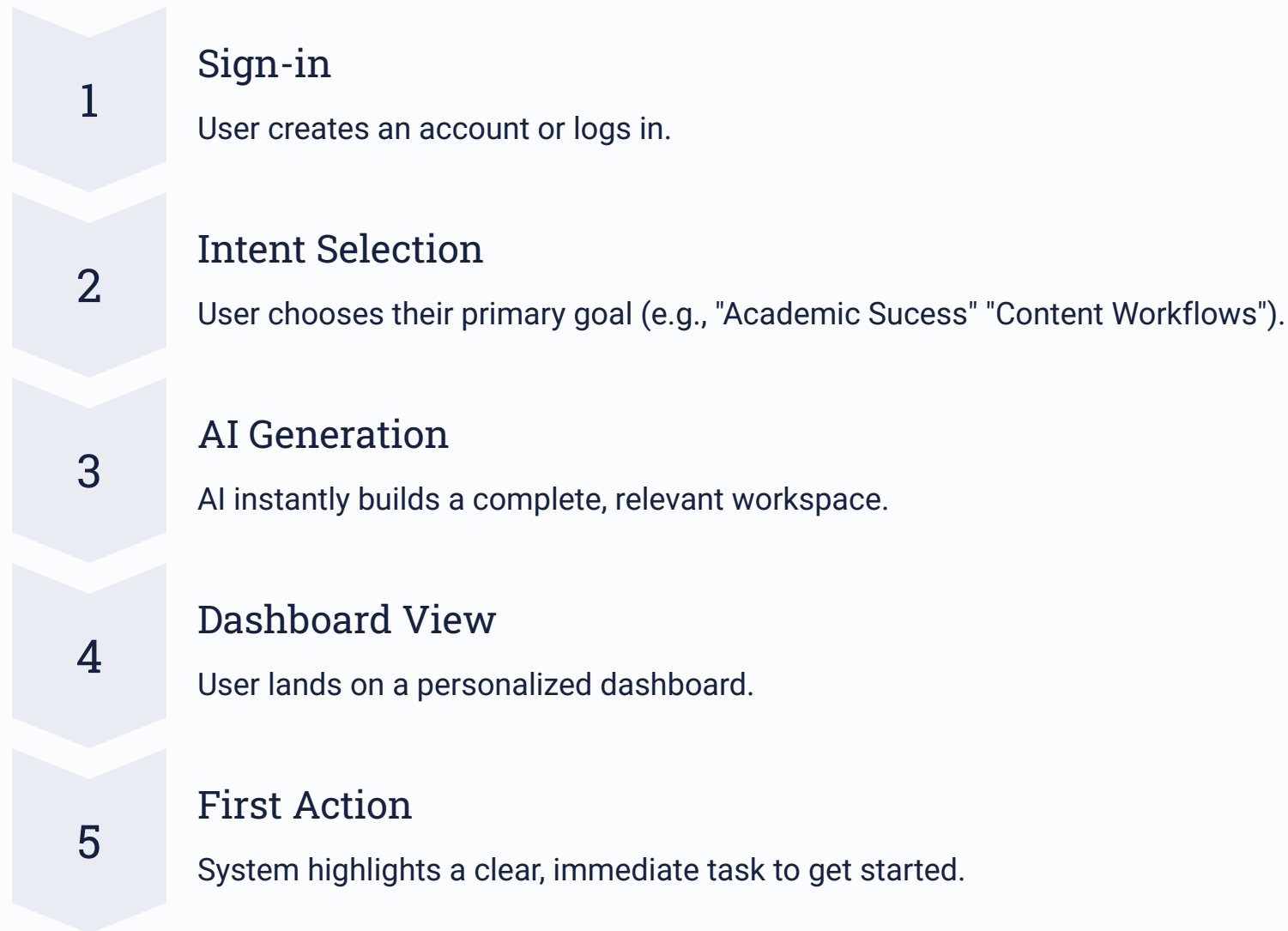
Users are presented with a guided next action, ensuring immediate engagement.

Proposed Experience: The Seamless Flow

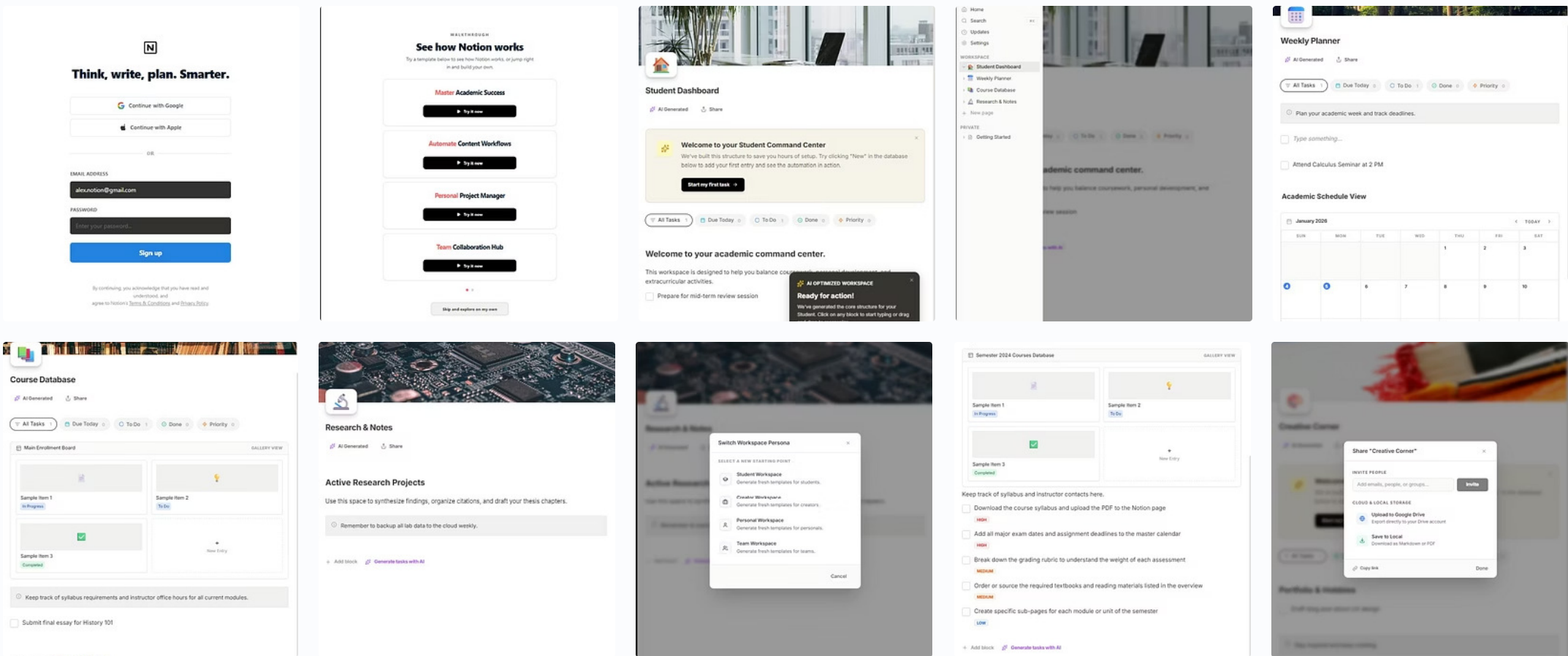
A guided, AI-accelerated journey from sign-in to meaningful action.



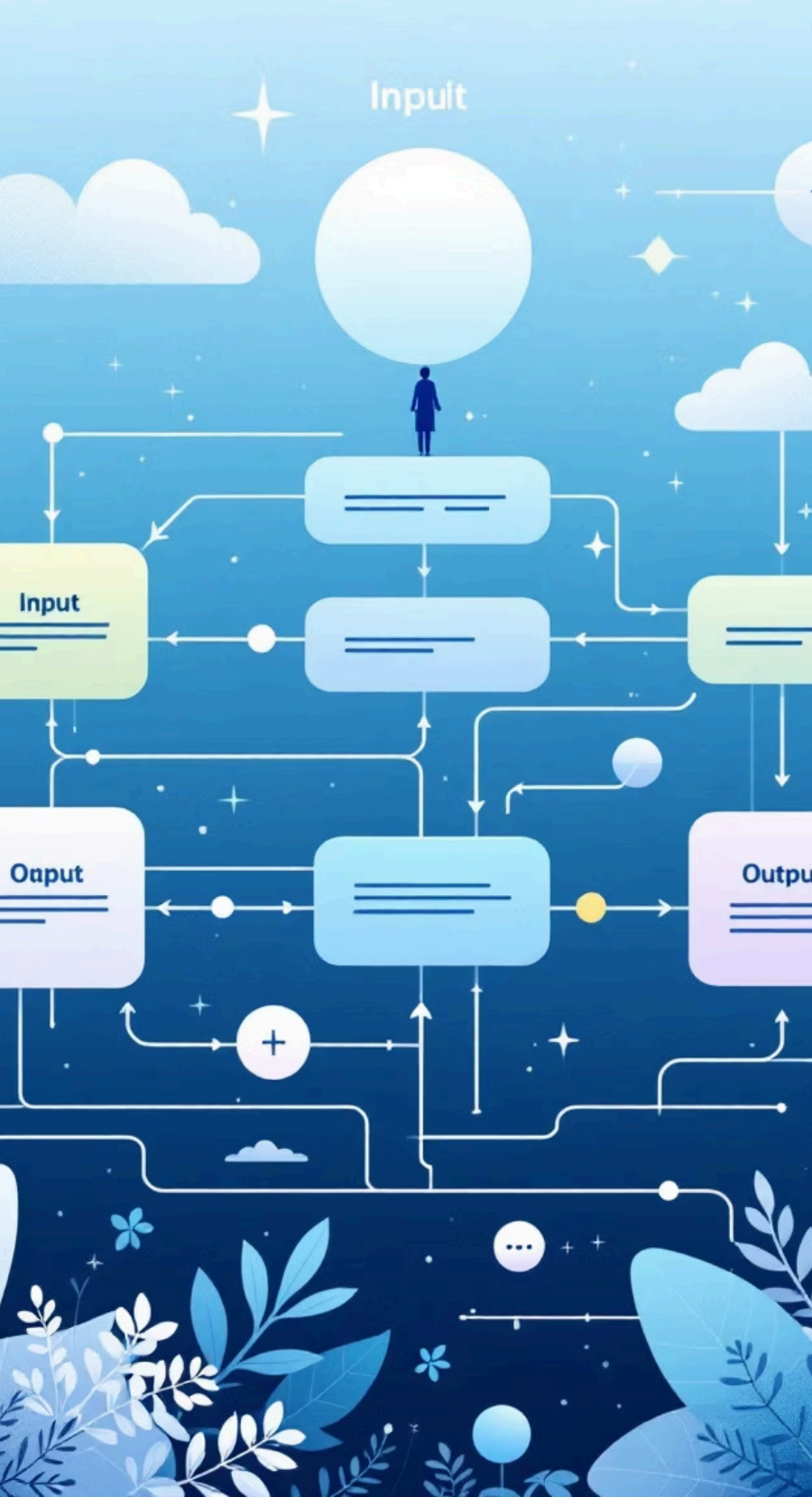
This experience ensures AI accelerates setup while preserving Notion's full editability for advanced users.

How the AI Works: Intent-Driven Structure

The AI operates on a logical framework, turning user goals into functional workspaces without opaque automation.

Inputs

- User-selected intent (e.g., "Master Academic Success")
- Curated workspace schemas (pre-designed structures)

AI Logic

- Selects the most appropriate schema
- Creates relevant pages and databases
- Adds starter content to fill key areas
- Identifies the most logical first action for the user

Outputs

- Fully editable, personalized workspace
- Clear, guided next step for engagement
- Reinforced sense of progress and accomplishment

Users remain in control, benefiting from AI-assisted setup without sacrificing flexibility.

Success Metrics: Measuring Impact

We will validate the effectiveness of AI onboarding through a combination of primary, secondary, and guardrail metrics.

Increasing the percentage of users who return within a day.

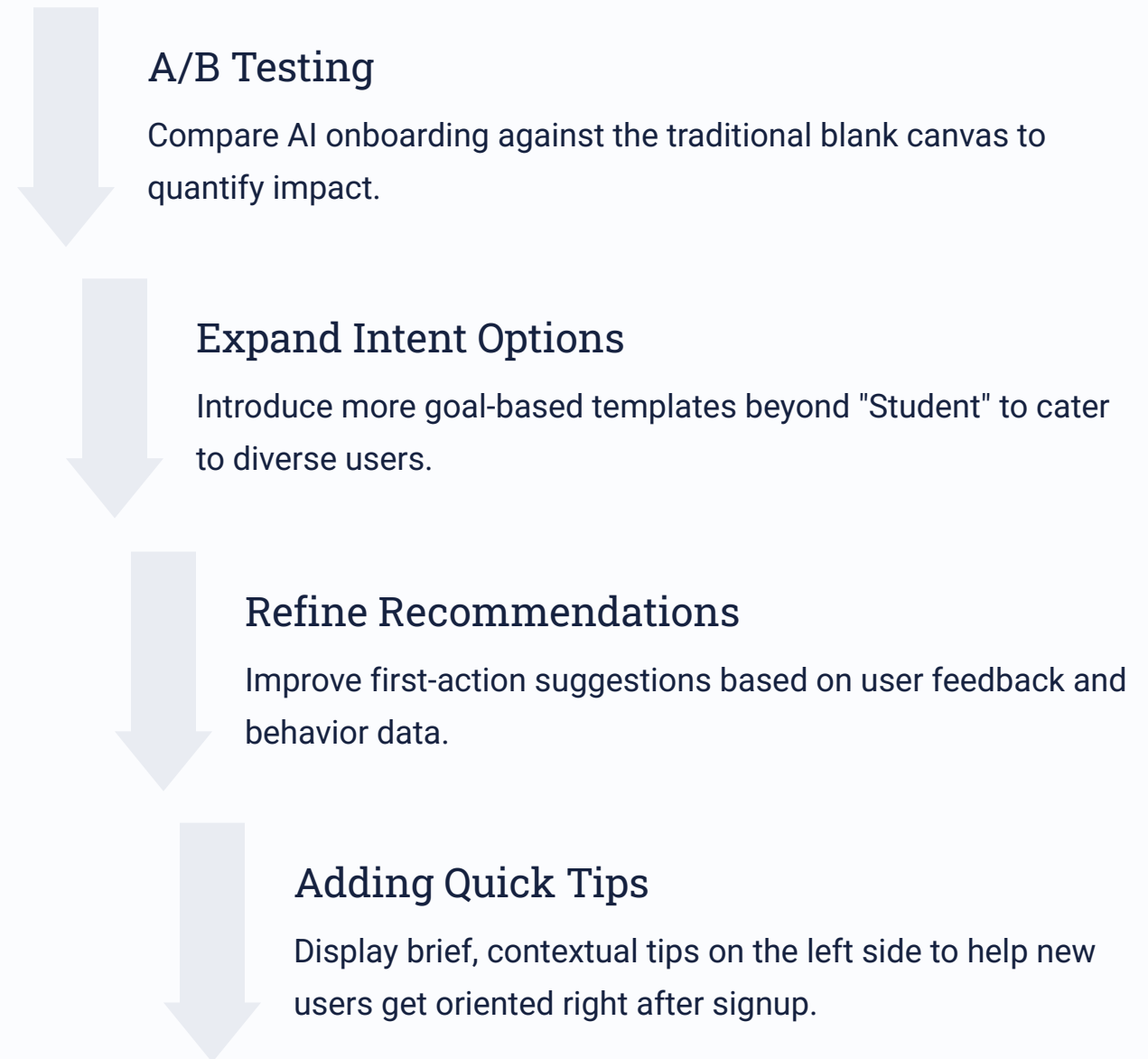
Guardrails:
